Lot 394: Following the recent opinion poll for Lot 394, the Board is working to engage architects to put together initial designs for development for the common area lot. Additionally, TD2 is working on the final replat for the four residential lots that will be added. Once TD2's work is finalized, we can issue it with Legal and get it under contract with builders.

The next Board meeting will be held at 8:00 a.m., on July 14, 2022.


There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon motion, duly made, seconded and unanimously carried the meeting thereupon adjourned.
